■ **About** our Service ■

THE CALL. The Lord calls His people to assemble, and we respond in song. This aligns with an ancient tradition that those going up to the temple would sing the Psalms of Ascent (Psalms 120-134).

CONFESSION. The Lord cleanses us of our unrighteousness through His Son, Jesus Christ, as we come into the Lord's glorious presence.

CONSECRATION. The Lord teaches us through the reading and preaching of His holy word. Our practice is to read from the prophetic word that anticipates the coming of the Messiah and from the fulfilled word that declares Jesus Christ as the Messiah.

COMMUNION. The Lord communes with His people in a ceremonial meal designed to build up the individual saints and the corporate church body. This meal emphasizes our unity as brothers and sisters in the faith under the Lordship of Jesus Christ.

The Lord's Supper is observed weekly as part of the covenant renewal service. All disciples of Christ under His authority are invited to partake. If you are a visitor who takes communion with your home church, please take communion with us. We encourage all who worship regularly with us to consider becoming a member or associate member with us. By partaking of the bread and the wine (actually grape juice), we are all proclaiming that we are sinners without the hope of salvation, were it not for the grace of God, and that we are trusting in Jesus Christ alone for our salvation.
